ORDER:

The Government of India, in the reference 1st read above, has brought out the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019 inserting Clauses 15 (6) and 16 (6) in the Constitution providing for 10% reservation in admissions into Educational Institutions and appointments to posts in favour of Economically Weaker Sections of citizens other than the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes.

- In pursuance of the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019, the Government of India have, in the reference 2nd read above, prescribed the eligibility criteria to get the benefit of 10% reservation in admissions into Educational Institutions and appointments to posts provided in favour of Economically Weaker Sections of citizens other than the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes among others
 - The persons who are not covered under existing scheme of 1) reservations for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes and whose gross annual family income is below Rs.8.00 lakh are to be identified as EWS for the benefit of reservation.

2) The persons whose family owns or possesses and of the following swara College of Engineering? assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS for the benefit of HERIA STRANGED AS THE STRANGED AS STRANGED AS THE ST

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Five (5) Acres of agricultural land and above.

ii. Residential flat of 1000 Sq. Ft. and above.

iii. Residential plot of 100 Sq. Yards and above in notified Municipalities / Corporations.

iv. Residential plot of 200 Sq. Yards and above in areas other than notified Municipalities / Corporations.

The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS

The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years.

- After passing of the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019, the Government of Andhra Pradesh have bifurcated the 10% reservation and brought out two Acts, namely, Act No.14 of 2019, Dated.20.02.2019 and Act No.15 of 2019, Dated.20.02.2019, providing for 5% reservation to Economically Weaker Sections among Kapus and 5% reservation to Economically Weaker Sections among other than Kapus respectively, towards admissions into Educational Institutions and appointments to posts in the Public Services under the State. There shall be $1/3^{\mbox{rd}}$ horizontal reservation for women within in the reservation provided both to Kapus and other than Kapus.
- In the reference $4^{\mbox{th}}$ read above, the Government have issued orders bringing the provisions of the Act 14 of 2019 and Act 15 of 2019 into force with effect from 08,03,2019.
- In the reference 5th read above, Government have constituted a Committee for formulation of draft guidelines for implementation of 5% reservation provided to Economically Weaker Sections among Kapus and 5% reservation provided to Economically Weaker Sections other than Kapus.
- Meanwhile, a Writ Petition bearing No. WP (CIVIL) No. 343 OF 2019 with 6. I.A.NO. 45038/2019 has been filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India praying for quashing the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019 as violative of basic structure of the Constitution and also quashing Act 14 & Act 15 of 2019 enacted by Government of Andhra Pradesh as being violative of Articles 15 (1) & 16 (2) of the Constitution.
- In the reference $7^{ ext{th}}$ & $8^{ ext{th}}$ read above, two Writ Petitions have been filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh praying for issuing an appropriate Writ or Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to the respondents to notify the Rules for implementing the 10% reservation provided to Economically Weaker Sections among Kapus and other than Kapus in Act No.14 of 2019 and Act No.15 of 2019 enacted by the State of Andhra Pradesh.
- In the reference 9th read above, one more Writ Petition has been filed before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh praying for issuing an appropriate Writ or Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring Act No.14 of 2019 and Act No.15 of 2019 as ultra vires and un-constitutional, violative of the purport of the 103rd Constitutional Amendment Act, 2019 and violative of Article 15 of the Constitution of India and consequently, Act No.14 of 2019 and Act No.15 of 2019, have to be struck down. The Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh passed the following interim orders in this case;

"Notice before admission.

PRINCIPAL Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering & Technol-Petitioners filed the Writ Petition seeking Mandary RO ACTETCHERLA, Srikakulam-532410 (A.P.) 14 and Act 15 of 2019, as ultra vires, unconstitute the purport of the 103rd Constitutional Ame

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Article 15 of the Constitution of India and consequently to strike down Act 14 and Act 15 of 2019.

Petitioners also sought interim relief, to direct the Respondents 6 and 7 to follow 103rd Constitutional Amendment Act during admissions into Medical and Engineering Courses and allot seats in the supernumerary seats created by the 4th Respondent, only in accordance with the policy of the 4th Respondent, with regard to Economically Weaker Sections, pending disposal of the writ petition.

It is the case of the petitioners that Act 14 and Act 15 of 2019, creating reservation in Educational Institutions to Kapu community based on their economic backwardness, is contrary to the 103rd Amendment.

In fact, it is brought to the notice of the Court that a petition challenging 103rd Constitutional Amendment is pending before the Honourable Supreme Court, but the main contention is that Act 14 and Act 15 are inconsistent with the purport of 103rd Constitutional Amendment. At this stage, it is not possible to decide the core issue i.e. the vires of Act 14 and 15 of 2019, making another class within the original class, without inviting counter-affidavit from the respondents.

Therefore, there shall be a direction to the respondents to complete the admission process, pending further orders, subject to the result of the Writ Petition, by obtaining an undertaking from the petitioners to the effect that in case the petitioners do not succeed in the writ petition, they shall not claim any equities in future based on the admissions.

Post after three weeks, by which time respondents shall file their counter-affidavits".

In view of the above Government hereby decided to fill up the EWS quota of supernumerary seats in Figher Educational Institutions in accordance with 103rd Constitutional Amendment Act, 2019 and the guidelines issued by Govt., of India vide Office Memorandum F.No.36039/1/2019-Estt(Res.) Dated: 19.01.2019. The guidelines relevant for current academic year 2019-2020, in regard to the subject matter consistent with 103rd Constitutional Amendment, would read as under:

i. All Castes which are not covered under any reservation category (SC / ST / BC) are entitled to avail of the reservation facility under EWS Category.

i. The students admitted under EWS Category will be adjusted against the 10 percent of the sanctioned seats granted additionally, as is followed by the Government of India. However, 1/3rd (33 1/3) of the seats enhanced for the purpose of accommodating the EWS Category students shall be earmarked to women among them.

II. The model format of the EWS Certificate prescribed by Government of India Annexure-I vide their O.M.No.36039/1/2019-Estt. Dated: 31-1-2019 shall be followed along with the conditions referred in para

iv. The persons seeking the benefit of reservation under EWS category shall obtain the necessary EWS Certificate issued by the Tahsildar concerned.

v. The eligibility conditions for a person to avail of the facility of EWS reservation are the same as fixed by the Government of India as referred in Para 2 above:

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSe) for admission in Central Educational Institutions.

In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution (One Foundred and Third Amendment) Act 2019, and the reference of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment vide OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated 17th January 2019, enabling provision of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections (EV/Ss) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scharluled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes, it has been decided to provide reservation in admission to educational institutions subject to a minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of Anticle 30 of the Constitution of India.

- 2. The provision of reservations to the Economically Weaker Sections shall be in accordance with the directions contained in the DM No. 20013/01/2018-EC-II dated 17th January 2019 of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment and shall be
 - a) The reservations shall be provided to EWSs for admission in Control Educational Institutions, (as defined in clause (a) of section (2) of The Control Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006) from the accidentic year 2019.
 - b) The above reservation would not be applicable to the 8 institutions of excellence research institutions, institutions of national & strategic importance as the cified in the Schedule to The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006, as amended from time to time, and appended to this DM, and to the Constitution.
- c) Every Central Educational Institution shall, with the prior approval of the appropriate authority (as defined in clause (c) or section 2 of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2009), increase the number of seats over and above its annual parmitted strength in each branch of

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study or faculty so that the number of seats available, excluding those reserved for the persons belonging to the EWSs, is not less than the number of such seats available, in each category, for the academic session immediately preceding the date of the coming into force of this O.M.

d) Where, on a representation by any Central Educational Institution, the appropriate authority is satisfied that for reasons of financial, physical or academic limitations or in order to maintain the standards of education, the annual permitted strength in any branch of study or faculty of such institution cannot be increased for the academic session following the commencement of this Act, It may permit such institution to increase the annual permitted strength over a maximum period of two years beginning with the ecademic session following the commencement of this Act; and then, the extent of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections shall be limited for that academic session in such manner that the number of seats made available to the Economically Weaker Sections for each academic session shall not reduce the number and the percentage of reservations provided for SC/ST/OBC categories.

e) The scheme for implementing the reservation for the EWS shall be displayed on the website of the institution as soon as possible, but no later than 31st March

The Chairman LIGO, Chairman AICTE and Chairperson NCTE and the Bureau Heads of the Department of Higher Education in the Ministry of Human Resource Development responsible for management of the Institutions of National Importance are requested to ensure immediate conciliance of this OM.

4. This issues with the approval of the Minister for Human Resource Development.

However, this would not be applicable in the case of Minority Institutions referred to the Clause (1) of Article 30 of Constitution of India. Such Institution shall be permitted to increase in annual permitted strength over a maximum period of two years.
- 2. The Institution offering courses earlier in the Regular Shift, First Shift, Second Shift/Part Time are now amalgamated as total intake and shall have to fulfil all facilities such as Infrastructure, Faculty and other requirements as per the norms specified in the Approval Process Handbook 2022-23 for the Total Approved Intake. Further, the Institutions Deemed to be Universities/ Institutions having Accreditation/ Autonomy status shall have to maintain the Faculty: Student ratio as specified in the Approval Process Handbook. All such Institutions/ Universities shall have to create the necessary Faculty, Infrastructure and other facilities WITHIN 2 YEARS to fulfil the norms based on the Affidavit submitted to AICTE beginning with the Academic Year 2022-23
- Strict compliance of Anti-Ragging Regulation, Establishment of Committee for SC/ ST, Establishment of Internal Complaint Committee (ICC), Establishment of Online Grievance Redressal Mechanism, Barrier Free Built Environment for disabled and elderly persons, Fire and Safety Certificate should be maintained as Approval Process Handbook and provisions made in AICTE Regulation notified from time to time.
- In case of any differences in content in this Computer generated Extension of Approval Letter, the content/information as approved by the Executive Council / General Council as available on the record of AICTE shall be final and binding.

Pharmacy Institute: In compliance with the order dated 05.03.2020 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Transferred Petitions (CIVIL) No 87-101 of 2014, for the existing institutions offering courses in Pharmacy Programme, approval of Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) is mandatory and AICTE approval is NOT required.
